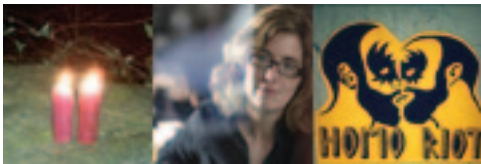
## About the Editors
