

Another Elegy

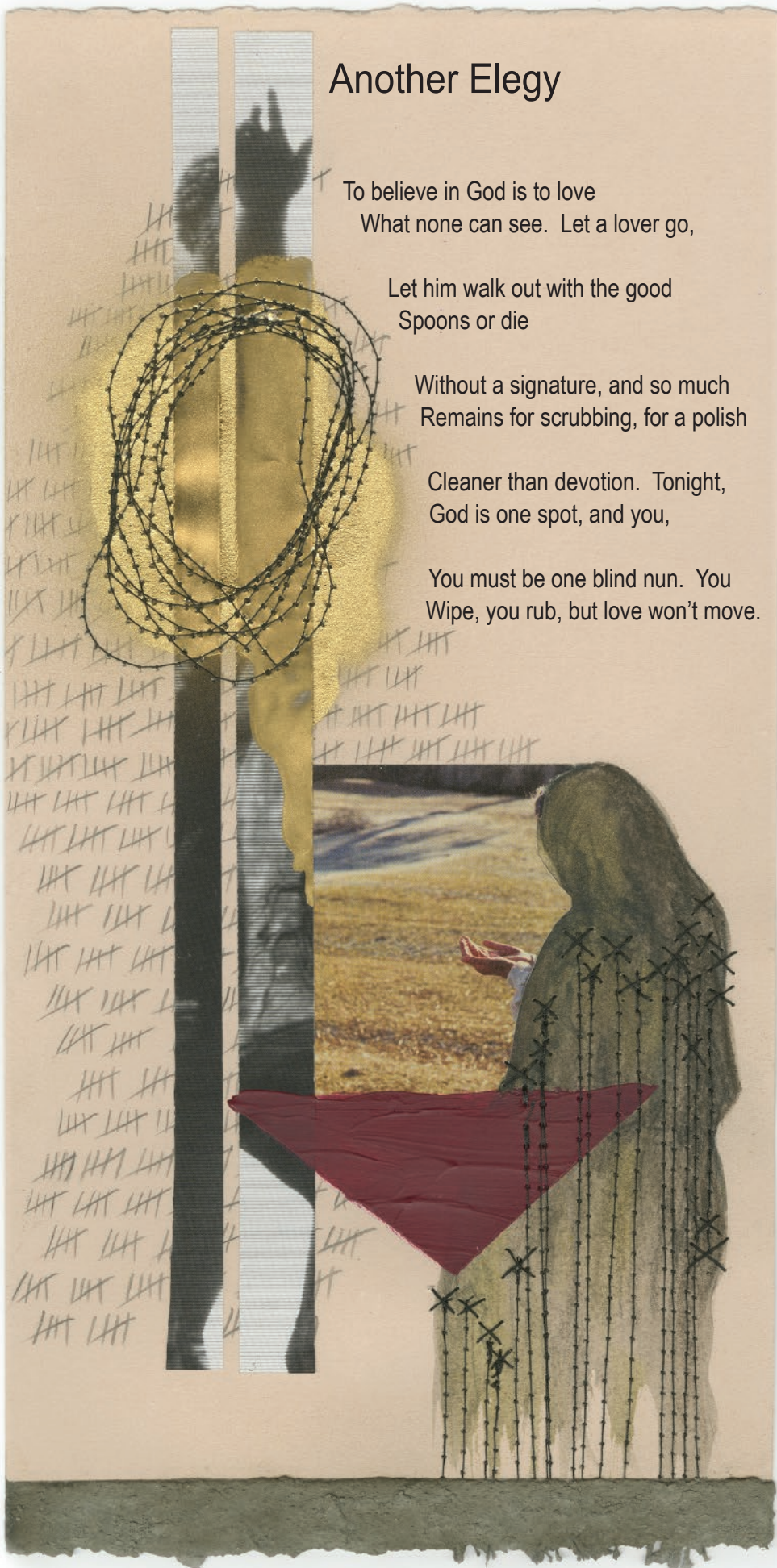
To believe in God is to love
